- **ORANGE** - WHAT IS ONE THING THAT DID NOT GO WELL TODAY?

STUDY ON TOGETHERNESS
CHECK OUT ACTS 2:42-47

AS A FAMILY, READ THIS PASSAGE OUT LOUD AND HIGHLIGHT OR NOTE ALL THE WAYS THE EARLY CHURCH DID THINGS TOGETHER. THEN TALK ABOUT HOW YOU MIGHT DO SOME OF THESE THINGS AS A FAMILY. IF YOU HAVE TIME, YOUR CHILDREN MAY ALSO ENJOY DRAWING PICTURES OF ONE OR MORE OF THESE ACTIVITIES. HAVE THEM TELL YOU ABOUT THEIR PICTURE AND THEN DISPLAY THE PICTURES WHERE YOU CAN ALL BE REMINDED OF WHAT YOU TALKED ABOUT. NOTE: FOR VERY YOUNG CHILDREN, YOU MIGHT WANT TO READ ONLY ONE OR TWO VERSES AND THEN EXPLAIN THE IDEAS IN SIMPLE TERMS—BUT THEY MAY SURPRISE YOU WITH WHAT THEY UNDERSTAND!
